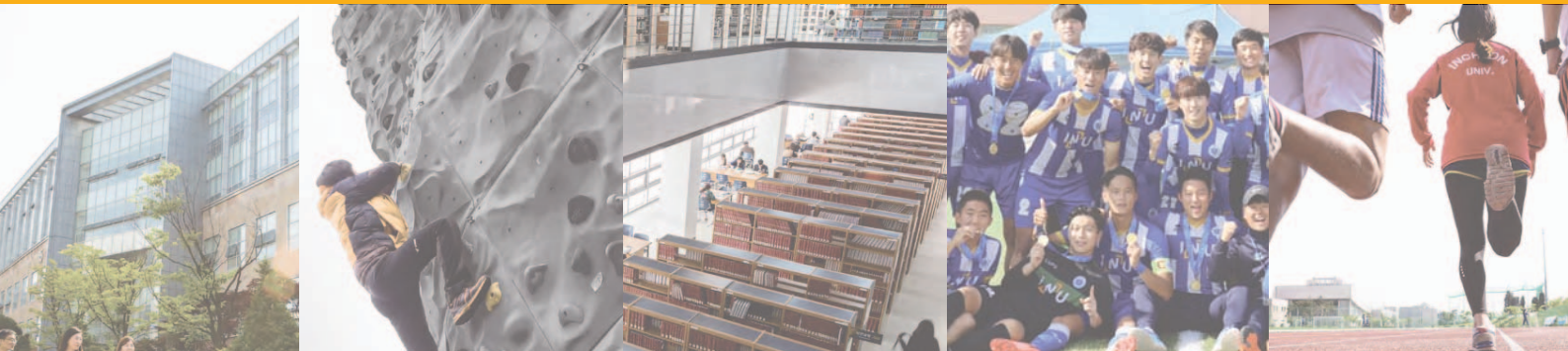

## 📖 Preparing the Documents (Academic Requirement)

### 1) Consulate Legalization

- English-written original documents can be legalized by Korean Embassy/Consulate without translation.
- Other language-written original documents should be translated into Korean or English and notarized.  
Documents must be legalized from Korean Embassy/Consulate after notarization.

### 2) Apostille

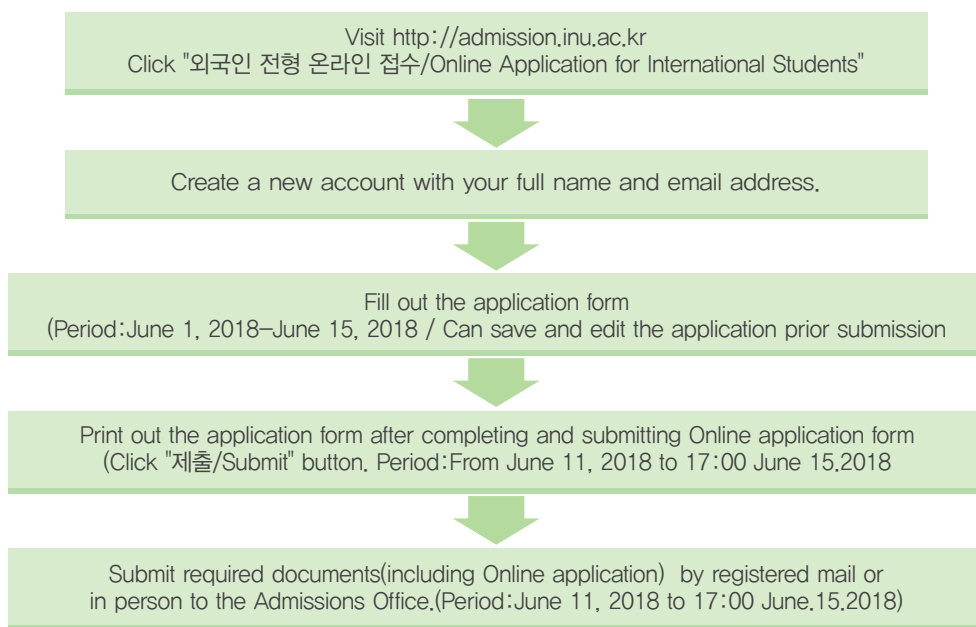
- After translation (English or Korean) and notarization of the original documents, you can apply for an apostille at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs office.
- Chinese applicants are not a party of the apostille agreement, (See Credentials Report or Consulate Legalization)



## 5 Notes of Application Form and Submission

(1) After completing the online application, applicants must submit all required documents. Applicants who fail to submit the required documents, even if their online applications are completed, will be excluded from the admissions process.

※ From June 1, 2018 to 17:00, June 15, 2018 applicants may fill out and edit their online application form. They must complete and submit the Online application form until 17:00 June. 15, 2018.



(2) Applicants must fill out the application form carefully and submit the documents correctly since the information and documents you have written and submitted will be used during the application period. If you have any necessary modifications, you must notify to the Admissions Office.

(3) The applicant's name should be correctly written (should match the applicant's passport).

(4) The applicant's name and alien registration number should be correctly written. If the applicant has an alien registration number, write it down correctly. If the applicant does not have alien registration number, write as follows.  
Ex) A male (female) student who was born in May 15, 1992: 920515-599999(6999999)

(5) Write down personal information such as high school, address, phone (mobile) number, e-mail address correctly (matching the submitted documents).

(6) The name of the school abroad written on the application has to be an official English name.

(7) Applicants must be Korean Language Certificate or English Language Certificate holders and write the score on application. The expiration date of the Certificate of Language should expire after the online application period has ended.

(8) Applicants who did not submit a language certificate before the deadline (due to the date of a language test) must express written notification on the application.

(9) Photos (3cm\*4cm) taken within 3 months are to be uploaded online and enclosed in the application package.

(10) If an applicant presents any false information, fails to submit required application materials or cannot be contacted, the applicant may be withdrawn from admission review.

(11) Applicants cannot change their major after the application period.

## 6 Important Notes for Applicants

### Notes about required documents

- (1) All submitted documents should be original copies (apostilled or verified by consular).  
In case that applicants need to submit the copy within the period, they have to bring the original copies to get a confirmation from admissions staff. After that, they must submit the original copies.
- (2) Documents in languages other than English must have a notarized Korean translation attached to them with the certificate of translation.
- (3) The admissions staff reserves the right to require additional documents from applicants, should there be any need to clarify the eligibility or to verify the authenticity of the submitted documents.
- (4) After the required documents submission, it is not allowed to change or cancel it and submitted documents will not be returned.
- (5) Applicants whose graduation status is pending during the time of application should submit their graduation certificates to the Admissions Office of INU.

### Notes about cancellation of admission

- (1) The phone number (or mobile phone) of applicants should be filled in precisely. If an applicant cannot be contacted due to false information, the applicant may be withdrawn from admission review.
- (2) Any inaccurate information of successful applicant's academic background or others may cause the cancellation of admissions even though it will be realized after the semester starts.
- (3) Applicants should keep in mind of the checking of their academic background (e.g. Letter of Consent), if they do not cooperate with this, INU will consider this an academic problem. If the institution fails to verify the authenticity of student's documents, the admission may be revoked.
- (4) Failure to submit required documents or false entries in the documents (e.g. forgery falsification, examination irregularities, or ineligibility) will lead to cancellation of admission.
- (5) Admitted students should complete the registration process (payment of tuition fee) within the designated period. INU will rescind automatically the admission acceptance of applicants who fail to do so.
- (6) Failure to submit the graduation certificate before the semester start date may invalidate a student's offer of admission.
- (7) Admitted students to INU are not allowed to register for any other universities in Korea which are scheduled to hold the same academic year for admissions as that of INU. If an admitted student does not comply with this regulation, the offer of admission will be cancelled.
- (8) You must take responsibility for ensuring that you comply with the terms of your student visa. If your visa is refused, your admission will be cancelled.

### Etc.

- (1) Admitted students may not be allowed a leave of absence in the first semester by the regulations of INU.
- (2) This Guide Book is originally written in Korean and translated in English and Chinese.  
The Korean Guide Book prevails over translated versions in case of any conflict over other languages.
- (3) Matters that are not stipulated in the guide shall comply with the admissions procedures and regulations of INU, related law, policies, and decisions of INU Committee of Admissions. After the start of the semester, students follow the regulations of INU.



## Selection method

 Interviews will be conducted for applicants who pass the document screening process

### Interview Information

1. Location of interview

1) INU Songdo Campus (Korea Resident) : will be announced (Interview Date : July 4, 2018 –Wednesday)

2) Overseas resident(China) : Interview via video conference held at :

- ① Yantai University : Qingqual Road 30, Laisan, Yantai, Shandong province, China
- ② Dalian University of Foreign Languages : No.6 West of Lvshun Road South, Dalian, China

※ If you wish to have an interview in China, please indicate the venue on the application form.

※ If few students apply for an interview overseas, it could be cancelled.

※ The location and time for interviews are subject to change. Announcement will be posted on the INU website.

3) Applicants who reside outside of Korea may apply for the online interview.

(More information will be announced for online interviewees.)

### Evaluation

1. The interview evaluates knowledge of major, personality and Korean language proficiency.

2. Evaluation: A (100), B (90), C (80), D (70), E (60)

### Selection Criteria

– Students will be selected based on scholastic aptitude and language proficiency.

– Disqualification:

- 1) More than 2 criteria receiving an evaluation level of 'E' through the interview
- 2) Not eligible for studying at INU
- 3) Not attending the INU admission interview

※ Official ID such as an alien registration card or passport is necessary for your identification during the interview.

### Notification of Admission

– Notice will be posted on the website . (No individual notification provided)

– Students accepted by INU should be fully aware of all the comments from the website.

– Acceptance of admission could be cancelled if the tuition fee is not paid within the specified period.

– Acceptance notification and registration invoice are accessible through the INU website during registration.

– When paying the tuition fee via wire transfer from overseas, the student must wire the amount including the international wire transfer fee.

– Dual registration is not allowed. If a student is accepted at two universities or more, the student must register at only one university. Violating this policy may result in revocation of admission to INU and others.

– Refund Policy

An admitted student who wishes to withdraw from the acceptance of INU must submit the “Designated Withdrawal Form” and a copy of a Korean bank book to the Admissions Office. If withdrawing after the designated period, refunds will be made according to the university policy.
